(本報訊)1 月 30 日晚上大約 10 點多 鍾,我的電話突然有緊急警報後,看到微信群 里發出的照片和文字:亞洲城 43 街與 Superior 大道交叉處有房屋起火,還看到照片上 大火還在燒,有警車和消防車在搶救,一小時 後,消防隊已控制火勢,中國新年就要來了, 希望大家安全平安。

克利夫蘭冬天較長,這幾天下雪,請大家多多關注預防家庭火災,務必做到三清三關,即:清廚房、清陽臺、清走道,關電源、關火源、關氣源。另外要清楚住宅周圍環境,熟悉逃生路線。大火來臨時,請千萬不要着急,人要保持安靜,要迅速正確逃生,不要貪戀財物,逃生途中不要攜帶重物,以免失去逃生時機。應披上浸濕的衣物、被褥,儘量使身體貼近地面向安全出口走,用濕毛巾捂住口鼻,躱避火災中致命的煙氣傷害。切記,逃離火場後,不要冒險返回火場。

目前還不知道怎么發生,每一個人的安全健康第一,春節來臨,大家在吃火鍋的時候,要注意瓦斯問題等,祝福大家過好年。
