Actress Yin Chang, as "Mei Kwan" in Walt Disney's new movie PROM, will be attending 2011 Cleveland Asian Festival. Chang will be doing meet and greet as part of one of the vendor, The Event. Aside from her movie, she is most recognized for her role as 'Nelly Yuki' on CW's Gossip Girl. Chang has also appeared on NBC's Law & Order: SVU and Law & Order: Criminal Intent and ABC's Six Degrees. Additionally, you can catch her as a guest star in NBC's new upcoming show Love Bites. Currently, Chang is set to



star in Lifetime's new original movie.

Chang is featured in several publications, such as Variety and a spread in Seventeen. She was selected by NYLON Magazine as one of the 45 Young Hollywood stars of the next generation. Hudson Jeans noted Chang as one of the 14 rising young stars of the "Young Hollywood Generation". Mochi Magazine ranked her third out of the 25 prominent young Asian American influences under 25. Chang has also been featured on popular media outlets with the likes of E! News and AOL's Cambio News.

Chang, born and raised in New York, is the eldest of three daughters. She is of Taiwanese and Chinese, Malaysian ancestry.

Dat Phan at Cleveland Asian Festival!

Dat Phan was born in Saigon, Vietnam and immigrated with his mother to San Diego, CA. He suffered through financial hardships most of his childhood. After 9/11 he realized life was short and decided to go for his dream to pursue comedy full time. Moving to LA he had to live out of his car and even after being robbed at gunpoint he wouldn't stop pursuing his dream. Dat answered phones for The Improv in Hollywood during the day and tried to get as much stage time as possible at night; this meant he often went on well after

midnight when crowds were often more drunk than coherent. Later, Dat took the risk and auditioned for the experimental, comedy based show produced by NBC that would launch his career. The rest is history as he was named the funniest person in America on August 5, 2003

Dat's culturally insightful comedy inspects ridiculous stereotypes, and shares his experience of being a regular American guy with a Vietnamese heritage. His youthful energy and truly unique life experiences, including all the tough times, are combined to create the message of living your dreams and reaching out for the stars. Dat Phan's mission is to bring a more positive portrayal of Asian-Americans to mainstream entertainment and Hollywood. "We want to be seen as more than just martial artists, or bad stereotype token roles in American TV &

Movies."

Dat Phan has been included in The Smithsonian Institution's exhibition of The Top 10 Most Influential Vietnamese-American Individuals. The DVD "Dat Phan Live" was released in January 2010 and is available from Amazon.com. Dat's latest CD, "You Touch, You Buy" is now available on iTunes.
