

1) Princess Shuangyang《双阳公主》 Princess Shuangyang by Yu Qiaoyun于巧云

When Princess Shuangyang of Shanshan Kingdom was hunting in the countryside, she met a wandering man named Diqing. They fell in love and got married. However, pressing matters at home forced Diqing to return home to the Song Dynasty capital, so he lied to Princess Shuangyang and started his return journey right away. Zhou Yu and Huang Gai of the Wu Kingdom devised a cunning ruse. Huang Gai, a loyal general who had served three monarchs, volunteered to falsely surrender to Cao Cao of the Wei Kingdom. Late the night before, Zhou Yu comes to bid farewell to Huang Gai. This is a scene that requires singing skills in a young male role and a painted face.

8) Monkey King Battles the Water Demon 《泗州城》

Water Demon by Yang Fan杨帆, Monkey King by Lu Meng昌蒙

This scene is based on a combination of history and myth. A Water Demon was wreaking havoc on the town Sizhou (a town Huai River historically prone to flooding), so the Monkey King led an army of heavenly guards to defeat her. After the battle, the people of Sizhou finally regained their peaceful lives.
