

美國印州博爾大學慶祝一百周年，頒獎最資深教授張德光



張德光教授在辦公室

印第安納州星報三月二十五日專欄報導：印第安納州州立博爾大學慶祝成立一百周年紀念，頒獎最資深教授張德光。他現年93歲，在該校政治學系擔任教授已五十二年，現仍任教如常，並無退休計劃，受到該校校長頒予杰出教授獎狀及金質校徽獎章。

張德光教授1925年9月15日在中國福建省長汀縣出生，家學淵源，父親張贊堯是教育家，為鄉村現代化教育的創辦人。張德光在福建省立長汀中學畢業，廈門大學政治學系肄業，台灣大學政治學系畢業，于西雅圖的華盛頓大學獲得政治學碩士，1966年

及太平洋研究委員會，為該會的世界大會領于“領導亞太研究四十年”的水晶獎座。

張教授為任教、研究、演講及參加會議，到過八十多個國家，在英國、巴西、阿根廷演講，曾任中央研究院美國研究客座

在華府的美利堅大學獲國際關係博士學位，即受印第安納州州立博爾大學聘任為政治學教授至今，為該校發展國際研究課程，任教國際關係、國際公法、國際組織、美國外交政策及亞洲研究等課程，獲選為亞洲研究委員會主席，及國際研究學會顧問。

張德光為世界性學術機構、國際政治學會（International Political Science Association）創辦亞洲，擔任主席，主持研討

研究員、國立政治大學外交研究所客座教授、國立台灣大學政治學系客座教授、中原大學客座授、在中山大學、淡江大學、逢甲大學、台中師大及彰化師大演講，獲選為美國富布萊特教授，在上海外國語大學美國研究中心任教一年，受廈門大學及新疆大學聘任為客座教授，並應邀在復旦大學、北京大學、武漢大學、西北大學、蘭州大學、新疆大學、上海師範大學、吉林東北師範大學、雲南民族大學等及瀋陽美國總領事館主辦的演講。

張教授在各國訪問，受到蒙古總統、圖瓦總統、捷克總統、巴拿馬總統、哥斯達黎加總統及斯瓦濟蘭國王接待，就國際友好與世界和平交換意見。

他受到美國總統雷根邀請，參加1985年白宮會報（White House Pre-submit Briefing, 1985），為他參加與蘇聯領袖戈爾巴喬夫的日內瓦高峰會議提供策略建議。

張教授致力促進國民外交，發展國際關

係。印州州長波文接受他的建議，為美國第一個州與台灣省、浙江省及歐亞各國城市建立姊妹友好關係。

張教授著作等身，出版書籍包括聯合國組織、柏林外長會議、美國外交政策與及2018年英國牛津出版與張安麟合編的“亞洲在世界政治手冊”（Routledge Handbook of Asia in World Politics），為“國際百科全書”及“中國百科全書”撰寫多篇專欄。

張教授桃李滿天下，英才輩出，包括畫加菲貓（Garfield Cat）的吉姆·戴維斯（Jim Davis）、聯合國副秘書長杰福力·菲費門（Jefrey Feltmen），博爾大學教育學院院長羅伊·威佛（Roy Weaver），以及沙特阿拉伯的阿卜杜拉阿濟斯國王大學教授沙第克博士（Dr. Sadig）。

當記者特別問張教授長期任教，為何不想退休，張教授答為“報恩”，感恩戴德，報答人類社會。

CELEBRATING 100 YEARS OF BALL STATE

Chang, 93, still teaching with enthusiasm at BSU

CHANG, 93, still - Some people decide to take on a life of retirement while they are in their 50s or 60s. Some work into their 70s.

This Kuang Chang just keeps on going. He's the longest-serving faculty member at Ball State University, having taught political science for almost 52 years.

He is 93 years old. And he has no plans to retire. I have someone, they come to my office and said, "Why do you want to teach?" Chang said, "Because I want to go back. I appreciate."

Chang has been a professor of political science at Ball State since 1966. With more than 50 years of employment at Ball State, he is the longest-employed faculty member on campus. Senior citizens have 45 plus years of employment, and two, Thomas Harris and William Mauer, both of the Miller College of Business, are about to reach the 50-year mark.

(Harris with at least 45 years as T. Roger McConnell of the College of Fine Arts (School of Music), Ronald Osborn of the College of Health (Department of Social Work), E. Gene Prussner of the College of Science and Technology (Department of Science), and James (Henderson) and Charles Venable, both of the College of Architecture and Planning.

Chang, who grew up in China, teaches American Foreign Policy, International Relations, and Asian and Pacific Studies. He focuses his teachings on the world's current events.

Chang has traveled the globe, visiting more than 70 countries for teaching, research and academic conferences. He has had the opportunity to meet many world leaders, including several U.S. presidents. In the 1980s, he spoke with then-President Ronald Reagan, even giving some words of wisdom while in, saying him to adopt an effective manner of response to criticism of the Strategic Defense Initiative.

In his 50-plus years, Chang has had many students, of course. He fondly recalls some of them.

"Who is the most famous person?" Chang asked before referencing the Declaration of Independence, Ben-Lih, Liberty, and the pursuit of happiness, and talking about the importance of law on someone's happiness. Then, back to the point.

"When I saw a sign that said 'I really love you' and a car painter, who is that?" Jim Davis?

Chang said he reached out to Davis when his daughter expressed an interest in art, and Davis offered to teach him something. Chang started to give him his address, and Davis said, "I know your address, I saw your student."
