

穆迪分析:川譜正走在2020 年輕松獲勝的路上

精彩內容:雖然川譜正面對彈劾調查,但據最新的穆迪分析的預測模型,川譜將在 2020 年輕松獲勝。

CNBC: 根據穆迪精確的選舉模型, 川譜正走在 2020 年輕松獲勝的路上

•穆迪分析顯示,如果經濟保持穩定,唐納德·川譜總統將輕鬆贏得 2020 年的連任。

•報告指出:“如果選民主要根據他們的錢袋子來投票,總統將碾壓競爭對手。”

•三種模型顯示,假設投票率平均,川譜至少獲得 289 張選舉人票和多達 351 張選舉人票。

•穆迪的模型已經過回溯至 1980 年的測試, 並且每次都是正確的 - 除了 2016 年, 當時它預示希拉里將獲得微弱的勝利。

根據穆迪分析公司部署的用來測算 2020 年競選的三種不同經濟模型, 唐納德·川譜總統看上去很可能會輕鬆贏得連任。

除非有任何不尋常的事情發生, 否則總統的選舉人團的勝利將輕鬆超過他在 2016 年擊敗民主黨希拉里·克林頓的得票數,當時為 304-227 票。

穆迪基於消費者對自己的財務狀況的感受、川譜任職期間股市所取得的成就以及失業率(已降至 50 年低位)的前景做出了預測。如果這些變數強勁,總統看來將再獲得四年任期。

這個建模在追溯至 1980 年的選舉中已經證明非常準確

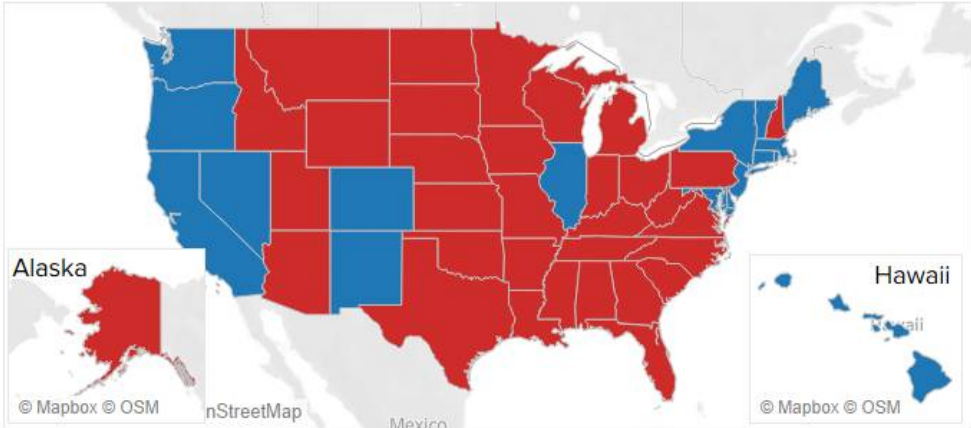

“如果從現在開始的一年後的經濟狀況與今天相同,或大致如此,那么現任總統優勢將很強, 川譜的當選概率會非常好, 特別是如果民主黨人不那么熱情並且不出去投票的話”, 穆迪分析的首席經濟學家馬克·贊迪(Mark Zandi)以及該論文的合著者,該公司政府諮詢和財政政策研究總監丹·懷特(Dan White) 以及助理董事兼經濟學家伯納德·雅羅斯(Bernard Yaros)表示。“這是關於投票率的問題。”

三種模型顯示,假設投票率平均,川譜至少獲得 289 票選舉人票。他的機會隨着民主黨方面的最高投票率而減少,而隨着預期的最低投票率而增加。

在這三種模型中,他在人們對自己的財務狀況的“錢袋子”衡量標準下表現最佳。在這種情況下,假設按照平均的非現任總統候選人的投票率,他獲得 351 張選舉人票,而一般民主黨人只有 187 張。“創紀錄的投票率對民主黨的勝利至關重要。”

在股市模型中,川譜獲得 289-249 的優勢,而在失業模型則顯示有 332-206 的優勢。在所有這三種模式中, 川譜以 324-214 獲勝。

“我們的 '錢袋子' 模式是這三種模式中最受經濟因素驅動的。如果選民主要基于自己的錢包投票,總統將碾壓競爭對手。”報告說。“這表明,在下次選舉中,家庭住戶層面普遍的經濟情緒的重要性會繼續保持。”

股市水平也很關鍵,兩者相互交織。贊迪說,就算在選舉期間,即使是非常普通的 12% 的市場調整也可能影響這場競選,與經濟的意外下滑一樣。

鑒于川譜一貫的低支持率(最新的蓋洛普民意調查為 40%) - 和大多數與民主黨人的一對一民調都顯示總統輸了 -

Donald J. Trump for President, Inc. and the Republican National Committee (RNC) today announced the members of the Connecticut Trump Victory effort, which will work to advance the agenda of President Trump and Republicans up and down the ballot. The Trump campaign team includes a Trump campaign honorary state chair and team coordinator. The RNC’s Connecticut team includes a regional political director.

“Our Connecticut Trump Victory leadership team will work to elect Republicans across the state,” said Brad Parscale, Campaign Manager of Donald J. BACKGROUND

Since President Trump took office, he has added 14,200 jobs to Connecticut’s economy, lowering the state’s unemployment rate from 5.6% to 3.6% after the state hit an unemployment peak of 9.3% under President Obama. Additionally, while President Obama lost 19,800 manufacturing jobs in Connecticut, President Trump has added 4,700 manufacturing jobs. President Trump has added money back into the paychecks of Connecticut voters, with the average Connecticut taxpayer receiving a tax cut of \$1,367. President Trump has lifted the prospect of voters across Connecticut, overseeing a 54,010 decline of Connecticut residents on food stamps.
