Happy Holidays! We are very excited to let you know the Cavs has extended their deadline till Mon. Jan. 6, 2020 for purchasing group tickets of Jan. 25, 2020 game. Once you reserve the tickets, we do need to have your payments by Jan. 6, 2020. As of today we have sold \$19 x 66 and \$45 x 133 tickets for a total of \$7,239 about 200 tickets as our stage one reservation. The Chinese Academy of Cleveland (CAOC) has about 40 performers and we have practiced every Saturday in Dec. before the holidays. We will have more intensive practices in January and feel free to stop by to support us during their practice. Our performers are including students from our Chinese as a Second Language (CSL) adult and children classes, CAOC's families and friends.

In order to prepare for our performance we have received great financial support from Taipei Economic Cultural Center so we have funding to purchase performers' outfits, meals and teachers' compensation due to CAOC is a non-profit educational entity with very minimum tuition revenue. Our TECO officials will come to Cleveland from TECO's Chicago office to be with us at the Cavs game. We appreciate TECO's support for helping us to make this happening. Besides TECO we also specially thank you for support from Berkshire Hathaway Professional Service (BHHS) \$45 x 10 purchase plus BHHS donated \$19 x 10 tickets to kids with severe special needs in Beachwood Middle school, Margret Wong and Associates (well known immigration attorney in Cleveland) donated \$19 x 10 tickets to Asian seniors and many tickets purchase from the CAOC friends and family.
