Rumor of Voinovich's retirement consideration: forget about it Posted by Stephen Koff



Trent Lott's announcement that he will retire from the U.S. Senate has prompted speculation of other politicians who could follow. Says MSNBC:

"Other Senate GOP veterans are also facing possible retirement decisions in 2010: Sens. Arlen Specter of Pennsylvania, Charles Grassley of Iowa, George Voinovich of Ohio, Christopher Bond of Missouri, and John McCain of Arizona. All of them except Bond are over age 70; Bond is 68."

But, says Voinovich's office: Ohio's senior senator is not retiring. "He is running for re-election," spokesman Chris Paulitz said this morning, when reached at a staff retreat near Athens, Ohio. "He's running, and he's running strong right now."

Federal Election Commission reports show just how strong. Voinovich raised \$440,023 in the quarter that ended in September, with about three—quarters of it from individual donors.

That leaves him with \$1.6 million on hand, and three years to raise a lot more.
